Aside from performing on the two festivals concerts, the choirs will be given the opportunity to explore Rome through guided tour.

DAY I

FRI, JULY 5 | 2:00 PM | ARRIVALS | FESTIVAL CONCERTS

Arrival to the hotel afternoon, check inn.

There will be two rehearsals prior to the festival one at the Churh. The first concert will be at the Church of Santa Maria in Portico in Campitelli. Every choir will get 15-20 minutes to perform.

. The church of Santa Maria in Portico in Campitelli is one of the oldest Marian shrines in Rome.

It was built by the architect Carlo Rainaldi, a pupil of Bernini, on the place where there was a previous church dedicated to S. Maria in Campitelli. The highlight is the stunning painted dome ceiling which is an amazing piece of artwork.

DAY 2

SAT, JULY 6 | 1:00M | CITY TOUR | FESTIVAL CONCERT

After breakfast, you can immediately launch yourself into discovery of the wondrous city of Rome. After meeting your guide in front of the Colosseum, you tour will be ready to begin. You will see the colosseum iconic symbol of the Eternal City has been synonymous with Rome for more than 2,000 years. In the evening, among the remains of the Temple of Apollo Sosianus, in the cloister adjacent to the church of Santa Maria in Portico in Campitelli choirs will take part in the Festival concert. Each choir performs a 15-20 minutes concert. Your repertoire is your choirs own selection. All choirs receives a memento of the festival, and finally the joint sing is performed again.

SUN, JULY 7 | 9:00 PM | DEPARTURE

After breakfast, transfer to the Airport for your return flight home, or choose to extend your stay in Rome with a customized extension.

DATES

CHURCH OF SANTA MARIA IN PORTICO IN CAMPITELLI

Dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary under a local Roman title of hers, Our Lady in the Portico, the church is a magnificent baroque ex voto: Pope AlexanderVII made it build on the site of a previous church dedicated to Santa Maria in Campitelli as a shrine for a small ancient icon of Our Lady that was believed by many people to have miraculously halted a terrible plague epidemic i n 1656. The project was entrusted to Carlo Rainaldi, a pupil of Bernini: the pope laid the first stone on 29 September 1660 and granted the Madonna the title of Romanae Portus Securitatis. On 14 January 1662, the icon was transported to the new temple still under construction.



CHIOSTRO DI CAMPITELLI AL TEATRO DI MARCELLO

The majestic theater of Marcellus, largely still preserved, is the only ancient theater left in Rome. Raised in the southern area of the Campo Marzio, between the Tiber and the Capitoline Hill, it was requested by Caesar and continued by Augustus. The theater is served as a model for the construction of the Colosseum. This building sets the pattern of the classical Roman theater, in which the cavea rests on masonry structures and not on a natural slope, as in the Greek theater. The sobriety of the façade structure made it a reference model for every future Roman theater and amphitheater.
