- 12 years and below
- 19 years and below

GROUP CATEGORIES OF PARTICIPANTS

Ensembles (4-11 singers) Choir (vocal groups over 12 people)

The festival invites all non-professional choirs to actively participate. Through participation choirs willbe able to garner valuable experience and have a better understanding of their present artistic level achievements.

A. CLASSIC Academic vocal. Classical contemporary pieces are welcome.

B. FOLKLORE The ensembles are asked to perform a folklore programme of their home country, which may include folksong arrangements without choreography, or a folk scene, a traditional costume or a scene with choreography from the daily life of the participants. The choreography should reflect traditional customs. The main emphasis should be on the vocal part. The singers are allowed to wear traditional costumes. Notice: In case sheet music is not available, a short description for the jury written in English is requested.

C. JAZZ, POP, MODERN all genres of modern choral music are welcome. Choirs have the possibility to perform programms from Jazz, Pop, Gospel, Spiritual, or Modern Choral Music. However, contemporary classical choral music should be presented in categories A.

When choosing the category please, keep in sight your choir's previous experience, results, capabilities in performances. Separate applications must be made for separate categories. Solo categories: Individual registration is required for each individual participant.

When choosing the pieces, you are kindly advised to carefully consider the whole structure of the programme.

Try to set up a well-balanced order of the pieces considering the dramaturgy and the different musical characters.

For each category, there is no restriction on the number of songs sung with or without original accompaniment. Choirs are required to prepare three songs subject to the following requirements:

One composition in the native language from the vocalist/ensemble's country.

The pure singing time limit for each category is as allocated. This time limit excludes the time incurred by applause or by stage entry/exit.

Each choir is allowed a maximum pure singing time of 15 minutes and 12 minutes (Children's Choir).

In selecting your programme take into consideration your choir's knowledge, the singers' abilities and age group. If it fits your programme choice, it would be advisable to incorporate your national choral traditions. The organisers are happy to help you in your category and programme's choice. Do not hesitate to contact us!

- The jury consists of a panel of five international choral experts. The decisions of the jury are final and cannot be contested.
- The evaluation of the Competition will be based on an internationally recognized evaluation system, according to the following criteria:

Technical Accuracy(30%)

Technique, Rhythm, Diction

Musicality (35%)

Interpretation, Improvisation, Musicianship, Dynamics, Breath Management

Sound Quality (30%)


Tone Quality, Pitch

Stage Deportment (5 %)

Attitude, Posture, Facial Expressions

Each adjudicator will give the scores independently.

The final result is calculated from the total sum of all final scores of the jury.





According to the scores attained, choirs will be awarded the following:



CATEGORY WINNERS

The choir that is awarded the Gold diploma with the highest score in a category will be the category winner.

Based on the jury's decision, Bronze, Silver and Gold Diplomas will be granted.

All participants will receive diplomas at the conclusion of three round of the competition.

SPECIAL JURY AWARDS

The jury may award special prizes for outstanding performances and unique presentations: the best conductor of the choir; the best concertmaster (accompanist) and etc.

VICTORIA AWARD WINNER

The choir with the highest total score, regardless of the category they compete is the winner of the Victoria Competition will receive the Trophy. The Victoria Award® in the amount of EUR 1,000 is given to the highest scoring choir (not lower than 98/100).

Competitors must be present during the Awards Ceremony to receive awards and evaluation forms from judges as they will not be sent by mail.

Choirs who wish to prolong their festival stay by an extra night or can arrive one day earlier. The cost per day per person varies.


The participating choirs at the International Competition shall book their hotel through the Agency authorised by Virtus Travel. This is an exclusive condition and integral part of the conditions for participation and there is no exception to this rule. All included services and rates of the event package are described in the agency offer sent to the requesting choir. The purchase of an accommodation package is two (2) nights minimum. The package includes hotel accommodation in B&B, the entrance to all the events organised during the event (concerts, competitions)

Round 1: Registration deadline for the competition, including submission of video: May 30th, 2024

Round 2: Competitive performance: July 18th, 2024

Round 3: Gala Concert of laureates and awarding ceremony.
